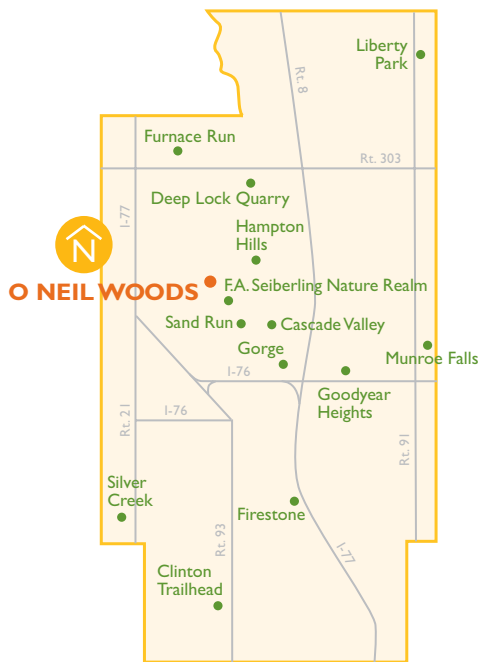




O'Neil Woods Metro Park



Enjoy hilltop meadows, picnic areas, hiking/biking trails, and some of the most spectacular views in Summit County.

O'Neil Woods was created in 1972 when the family of William and Grace O'Neil donated their family farm to Metro Parks. The property features breathtaking views of the Cuyahoga Valley from several hilltop picnic areas, the natural beauty of Deer Run Trail, and a unique opportunity to visit one of the few alder swamps in Summit County.

HOW TO GET TO O'Neil Woods Metro Park.

O'Neil Woods Metro Park is located off Martin Rd., south of Ira Rd. and west of Riverview Rd., in Bath Twp.

2550 Martin Rd., Bath

From I-77: Exit at Ghent Rd. Turn north on Ghent Rd. to Yellow Creek Rd. (approx. 1/2 mi.) and turn right. Take Yellow Creek Rd. approx. 1-1/4 mi. to Revere Rd. and turn left. Take Revere Rd. north 1/4 mi. to Bath Rd. Turn right on Bath Rd. and go 1/4 mi. to Shade Rd. Turn left on Shade Rd. go 1/8 mi. to Martin Rd. Turn right on Martin Rd. to the park entrance on the right.

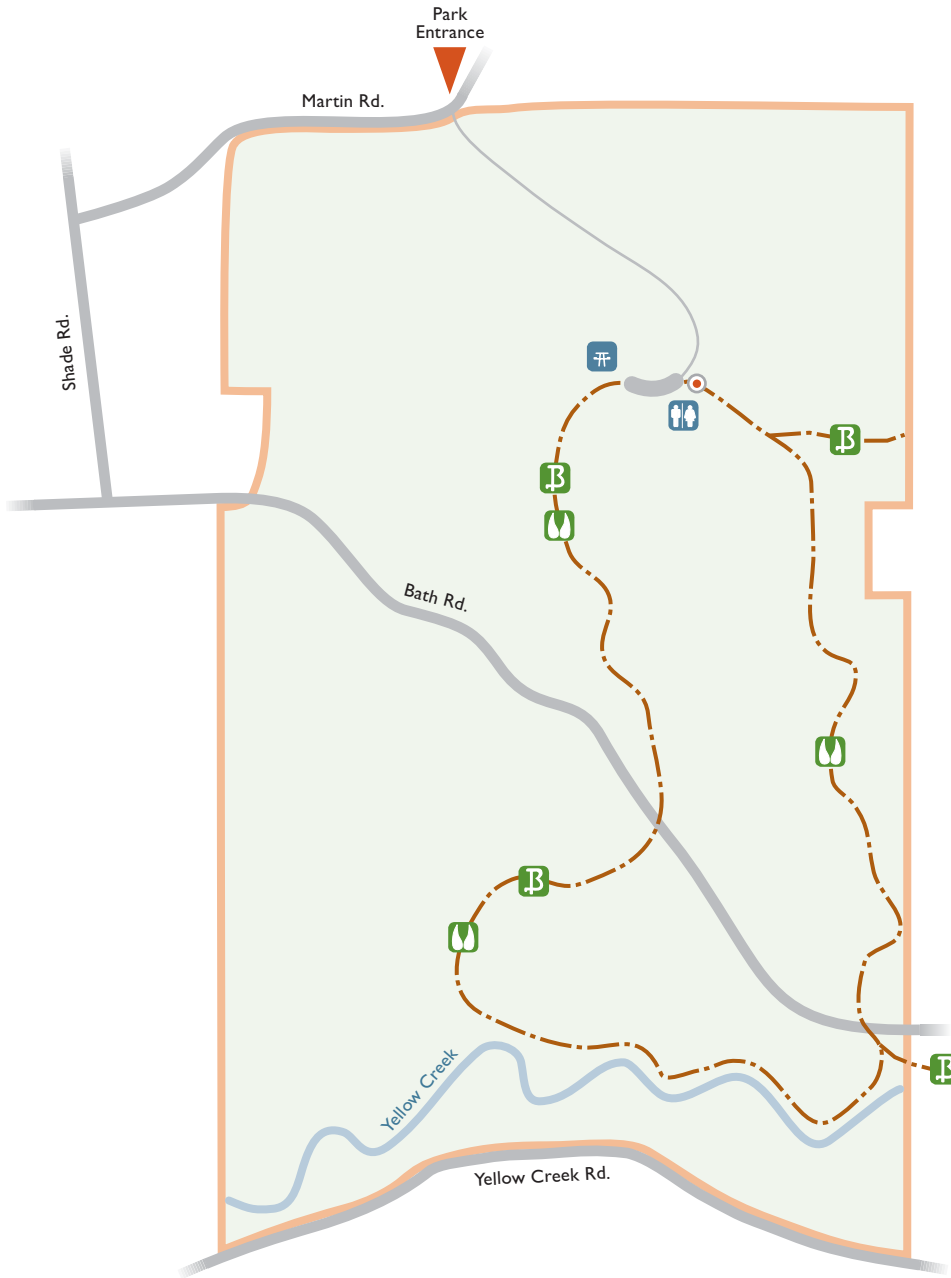
