A special autism-friendly hour will be held from 9 to 10 a.m., free of horns, music and flashing lights. The Summit DD Mobile Sensory Bus will be onsite for the full duration of the event (9 a.m. to 2 p.m.), where people with sensory needs can take a break from the stimuli of the event and calm their senses. On this fun-filled day, park district trucks will be available to sit in and explore. Equipment will include a dump truck, bucket truck, 1928 Model AA pickup and more! Visitors can also enjoy a sandbox with toy trucks and shop Maple Leaf Gifts, offering children's books, apparel and more.
