The Summit Metro Parks administrative offices (975 Treaty Line Rd., Akron) will be closed for the Thanksgiving holiday, Thursday, November 26 and Friday, November 27. Park offices (330-867-5511) will reopen Monday, November 30 at 8 a.m.
