SEASONAL OPPORTUNITIES IN THE METRO PARKS

BOAT ATTENDANTS

Boat attendants are hired to work at Munroe Falls and Silver Creek Metro Parks. Munroe Falls boat rental operations consist of paddle-boats. Silver Creek includes canoes, rowboats and paddle boats. Bait and concession sales, as well as light maintenance and cleaning of the equipment, are also a part of the attendants' responsibilities.

CONCESSION STAND WORKERS

Concession stand workers prepare, handle and serve food and snacks at Munroe Falls and Silver Creek Metro Parks. They are required to provide customer service, properly handle money and do light cleaning and maintenance.

GATE ATTENDANTS

Gate attendants are assigned to Munroe Falls and Silver Creek Metro Parks to collect entrance fees, provide public information and assist park visitors as they enter and leave the parks.

LIFEGUARDS

Lifeguards are hired to work at Munroe Falls and Silver Creek Metro Parks. Working as a team, lifeguards provide first aid and lifeguard coverage for visitors using the beach facilities. Beaches are open from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily and lifeguard schedules fluctuate to provide coverage. (Lifeguarding certification, CPR and aquatic test required.)



SEASONAL MAINTENANCE WORKERS

Our full-time maintenance staff is supplemented with more than 35 seasonal maintenance workers, who work together on daily clean-up of the parks, building maintenance, trail maintenance, mowing, trimming, weeding and general labor assistance on development projects. Seasonal maintenance positions are assigned to all Metro Parks locations. Hired each spring, these positions regularly work 40-hour weeks up to 120 days per season. (Driver's license required.)



SEASONAL PARK RANGERS

Seasonal park rangers are hired to supplement full-time ranger personnel. Seasonal park rangers patrol assigned areas to ensure visitors have an enjoyable, safe and pleasant experience.

Seasonal park rangers also administer special-use, pavilion and shelter permits. They serve as commissioned peace officers with tact, diplomacy and impartiality and work to prevent violations of park rules and other laws whenever possible. Patrols consist of assigned park properties on foot and, when necessary, with motor vehicles, ATVs or bicycles. (Required: Ohio Peace Officer Basic Certification, valid State of Ohio driver's license, valid CPR for the Professional Rescuer and Standard First Aid certifications obtained within eight weeks of employment.)
