TUBA GROUP PERFORMS HOLIDAY SONGS DECEMBER 15

The Tuba-Fours, an all-volunteer group of tuba players, will perform about an hour of music – including some seasonal holiday songs – Tuesday, December 15 at 7 p.m., at Coventry Oaks Pavilion in Firestone Metro Park (40 Axline Ave., Akron).

The name Tuba-Fours refers to the four-part harmony of their music.

The nine-member tuba troop is a subset of the Metro Parks Ensemble, which performs traditional marches, big band standards and oldies year-round. In colder months the Ensemble plays in Summit County senior-living facilities. In warmer months it plays outdoors in the Metro Parks.
