DAY CAMP: WINTER ADVENTURE Tuesday, December 29, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Firestone Metro Park / Coventry Oaks Pavilion 40 Axline Ave., Akron Campers will use a map and compass to explore the park, sledding and learning basic archery.
