Summit Metro Parks invites the community to join its Music by the Lake concert series, presented by Wayside Furniture.

Enjoy late spring and summer scenery set to a performance by the Metro Parks Ensemble. They'll play music from the big band era, Broadway musicals, children's films, marches, TV themes and more. The program varies each month.

Munroe Falls Metro Park concerts will be held at the Maple Shelter area (521 S. River Rd., Munroe Falls) on June 6, July 11 and August 1. Cycling without Age trishaw bikes will be available beginning at 6 p.m. to carry riders with limited mobility on a bench seat for an unobstructed view of nature and feeling of riding a bike in the outdoors.

Silver Creek Metro Park concerts will be held at the Sherman Shelter area (5000 Hametown Rd., Norton) on June 13, July 18 and August 8.

In 2023, Summit Metro Parks is celebrating the benefits of native plants through Wild Back Yards. The park district manages more than 15,000 acres throughout 16 parks, three nature centers and over 150 miles of trails, including 22 miles of the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail.
