Join Summit Metro Parks staff and native plant nurseries at the Native Plant Festival, presented by Wayside Furniture, on Saturday, May 20 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Munroe Falls Metro Park (521 S. River Road, Akron).

Visitors can browse a wide variety of native plants available for purchase, attend an educational session to discover the vital role native plants play in our ecosystem, sign up for the park district's <u>Grow a Wild Back Yard</u> program, enjoy entertainment and more. Visitors can receive a FREE plant, while supplies last!
