### GO FISH! ENJOY STOCKED LAKES AND PONDS IN SUMMIT METRO PARKS

Lakes and ponds have been stocked with fish for the season, and park district staff encourage visitors to cast a line in the Metro Parks. The following areas have been stocked this year:

#### APRIL 2022

- Brushwood Lake / Furnace Run Metro Park (4955 Townsend Rd., Richfield)
  - Catfish (10-12"), Trout (11-12"), Bluegill (6-8"), Bass (11-12")
- Little Turtle Pond\* / Firestone Metro Park (2400 Harrington Rd., Akron) *\*age 16 and under only*
  - Fingerlings: Catfish, Bluegill, Bass, Bluntnose Minnow
- Main lake / Munroe Falls Metro Park (521 S. River Rd., Munroe Falls)
  - Catfish (10-12"), Bluegill (6-8"), Bass (11-12")
- Tinkers Creek / Liberty Park (10303 Aurora-Hudson Rd., Streetsboro)
  - Fingerlings: Catfish, Bluegill, Bass, Bluntnose Minnow
- Wood Hollow Pond / Wood Hollow Metro Park (2121 Barlow Rd., Hudson)
  - Fingerlings: Catfish, Bluegill, Bass, Bluntnose Minnow

#### MAY 2022

- Alder Pond / Goodyear Heights Metro Park (2400 Harrington Rd., Akron)
  - Catfish (9-12"), Triploid Grass Carp
- Little Turtle Pond\* / Firestone Metro Park (2400 Harrington Rd., Akron) *\*age 16 and under only*
  - Catfish (10-12"), Bluegill (6-8"), Bass (11-12")
- Tinkers Creek / Liberty Park (10303 Aurora-Hudson Rd., Streetsboro)
  - Catfish (10-12"), Bluegill (6-8"), Bass (11-12")

#### JUNE 2022

- Main lake / Munroe Falls Metro Park (521 S. River Rd., Munroe Falls)
  - Catfish (10-12"), Bluegill (6-8"), Bass (11-12")
