CHILDREN INVITED TO SUBMIT ENTRIES FOR PARK DISTRICT'S KIDS' ART EXHIBIT

Young park visitors who enjoy creating works of art inspired by nature will have the opportunity to have their work displayed for the public.

From September 1 through September 30, kids ages six through 17 may submit entries for the first-ever Summit Metro Parks Kids' Art Exhibit, which will be displayed at the Nature Realm and virtually.

The theme for the exhibit is pollinators. A limit of one entry will be accepted per child, and all entries must be two dimensional in one of the following sizes: 5"x7", 8"x10" or 11"x14". Any media is acceptable, as long as it falls within the guidelines. With each entry, please include your name, address, phone number and email. Entries should not be matted or framed. Artwork will be returned.
