PUBLIC INVITED TO SUBMIT ENTRIES FOR PARK DISTRICT'S ANNUAL AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBIT

Park visitors who enjoy snapping photos in the Metro Parks will once again have the opportunity to have their work displayed for the public.

From September 1 through November 18, visitors may submit entries for the 23rd Amateur Photography Exhibit, which will be displayed in the Nature Realm and virtually.

A limit of two printed photographs will be accepted per entrant, and all images must be taken in areas managed by Summit Metro Parks. With each entry, please include your name, address, phone number, email, the location where the image was taken and a title for the image. Entries should not be matted, framed or include watermarks, and should be one of the following sizes: 5"x7", 8"x10" or 11"x14" and printed on photo paper. Please note that photographs will not be returned.

Visitors may drop off submissions at F.A. Seiberling Nature Realm (1828 Smith Rd., Akron or mail them to 975 Treaty Line Rd., Akron OH 44313, Attn: Amateur Photography Exhibit.
