

DIY WREN BOX



Making a bird box is a simple task and materials can be easily gathered or improvised. If this box is not your style, visit this [website](#) for other options!

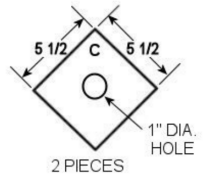
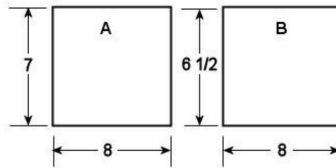
SUPPLIES



- Lumber 3' L x 8" W x 1/2" D
- Saw
- Wood Glue
- 10 Nails
- Measuring Tape and Pencil
- Square
- 1" Drill
- Hammer

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1 - Measure and cut: all lengths of wood to the dimensions shown at right and label for easier assembly.



Step 2 - Drill or cut an entry hole: use a 1" drill bit or cut the top corner of the front panel at 45 degrees with a saw.

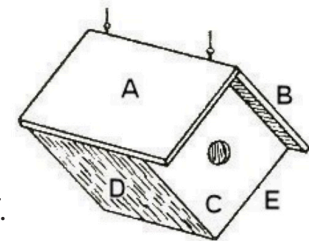
Step 3 - Glue and nail roof pieces: Overlay the longer roof panel over the shorter panel and glue and nail into place.

Step 4 - Glue and nail the side pieces: first to each other, then to the roof.

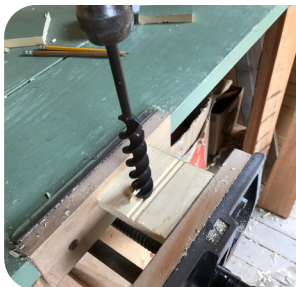
Step 5 - Glue and nail the front panel: to the roof and sides.

Step 6 - Attach the back panel: glue and nail into place, or if you want to take a peek, use pivoting nails, screws or hinges to attach the back panel or a side panel.

Step 7 - Display: connect to a post or hang from a tree and watch a busy wren couple build a nest and grow a family! *Be on the look-out for pesky house sparrows and promptly remove their messy nests to ensure native songbirds are the ones reproducing.*
