PLAY ON THE PARKWAY RETURNS FOR SECOND YEAR OF CAR-FREE SUMMER FUN

Summit Metro Parks invites the public to “Play on the Parkway” again this summer. Sand Run Parkway will go car-free between Portage Path and Merriman Road on weekends beginning in June and ending Labor Day weekend.

“We are excited to bring back Play on the Parkway after a successful inaugural season,” said Summit Metro Parks Executive Director Lisa King. “The program is a win-win for the public and for the environment.”

This nearly half-mile section of the parkway will be closed to motor vehicle traffic on Saturdays and Sundays to allow visitors to walk, jog or bike safely on the road. In addition to providing visitors with another way to enjoy Sand Run Metro Park, a car-free parkway helps protect endangered wildlife and sensitive habitats.

Runners and walkers who wish to extend their journey from the Sand Run Jogging Trail can now make a round trip totaling nearly seven miles. Parking nearest this section of the parkway is available at the Old Portage Area of Sand Run Metro Park.
