The Board of Park Commissioners for Summit Metro Parks will meet Tuesday, March 19 at 11:30 a.m., in the visitors center at F.A. Seiberling Nature Realm (1828 Smith Rd., Akron). All petitions, applications and communications intended for consideration by the board must be in writing and received by the district's executive director at least five business days before the board meeting.

Immediately following the board meeting, commissioners – who are also trustees for the Summit Metro Parks Foundation – will conduct a Foundation meeting. When three or more of the district's commissioners meet to discuss park-related business, it is a public meeting.
