maintenance, safety and service to the public. Responsible for maintaining buildings and structures and to keep the electrical, mechanical, plumbing facilities and equipment in good working conditions. Assist with the construction of park

improvement projects.

**Qualifications:** Graduation from High School or GED required. Specialized training in

automotive and construction trades preferred. Minimum of three years of experience performing mechanical, plumbing, heating, cooling equipment maintenance, and competent mechanical aptitude. Experience in the operations of dump trucks with air brakes, and with or without trailers required. State of Ohio Commercial Driver's License, Class A required with driving record in compliance with Park District's policies. First Aid and CPR certification required within first year of employment. Trench and excavation competent person certification within 2 years of employment. Load Securement training

within I year. Confined space training within 2 years of employment. Certification in HVAC, electrical, ASE, plumbing, welding preferred.

General Statement of continued employment:

Internal transfers must successfully complete a 30-day probationary period. Part-time employees promoted to full time must successfully complete a 180-day probationary period, per Article 3, Section 3 of the 2022-2025 agreement between Summit Metro Parks and Ohio Council 8 & Local 1229 of the AFSCME,

AFL-CIO. Must achieve drug-free workplace compliant screening results,

including THC and alcohol.
