(OPOTC) certification required. Associate's degree or higher or minimum of sixty (60) semester college academic hours preferred. One (1) or more years' experience in parks, natural resources or comparable law enforcement preferred. Lateral law

enforcement transfers accepted.

Knowledge & Abilities: Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing, and to make timely and effective

decisions. Ability to carry and use effectively brush fire fighting tools and equipment. Ability to move barricading to locations where needed, or to move emergency supplies, equipment or materials to locations within the park district. Maintain knowledge of currently applicable procedures, policies, and court rulings regarding laws of arrest, search and seizure. Maintain skill level with defensive equipment to meet State of Ohio

requalification requirements. Ability to operate vehicles safely.
