Main Shelter at Munroe Falls Metro Park

Capacity is 80. There are 10 picnic tables (none are universally accessible), 4 standard charcoal only grills (charcoal not provided), 2 electrical outlets and drinking water. There is a playground, and a large field near the shelter. Also available at Munroe Falls Metro Park: hiking trails, basketball court, volleyball court, and fishing. The shelter is approximately 100 feet from the parking lot and is not universally accessible. Parking may be limited. See the Permit Information and Guidelines sheet for details.

The restrooms are approximately 140 feet from the shelter and are not universally accessible. There are lights inside the shelter, but not in the parking lot. Pets are **not** permitted in the buildings, shelter, & picnic areas of the park. Always check the Summit Metro Parks website's "**Alerts**" page for the latest information on park conditions, including any trail closures. **Smoking Restrictions:** No person shall use tobacco or vapor products inside public buildings, lodges, open-air shelters, and during public programs. No person shall throw or place upon the ground or within lakes and waterways any lighted match, cigar, cigarette or other burning substance.

Directions:

Coming from the south: take Route 8 North to Cuyahoga Falls and exit at Portage Trail. Turn right and go to Munroe Falls Avenue (at the first traffic light). Turn left onto Munroe Falls Avenue and travel approximately two miles to State Route 91. Turn right on State Route 91 (South Main Street) and go approximately ¼ of a mile to South River Road. Turn left on South River Road and go one mile to the park entrance on the right.

Coming from the north: take Route 8 South to Graham Road. Turn left and go approximately 2 miles to State Route 91. Turn right on State Route 91. Cross over the Cuyahoga River and railroad tracks; go through the light at Munroe Falls Avenue. After the light at Munroe Falls Avenue, go approximately ¼ of a mile to South River Road. Turn left on South River Road and go one mile to the park entrance on the right.
