Capacity is 48. There are 6 picnic tables (none are universally accessible), one large charcoal only grill (charcoal not provided), no electrical outlets or drinking water available, access to hiking trail, and a small playfield. Boat rental (summer season only), playground, and fishing are within one mile. The shelter is approximately 200 feet from the parking lot and is universally and easily accessible. Parking may be limited. See the Permit Information and Guidelines sheet for details.

The restrooms are approximately 150 feet from the shelter and are universally accessible. There are no lights inside or around the shelter or in the parking lot. Pets are **not** permitted in the buildings, shelters, picnic, and play areas of the park. Always check the Summit Metro Parks website's "**Alerts**" page for the latest information on park conditions, including any trail closures. **Smoking Restrictions:** No person shall use tobacco or vapor products inside public buildings, lodges, open-air shelters and, and during public programs. No person shall throw or place upon the ground or within lakes and waterways any lighted match, cigar, cigarette or other burning substance.

Coming from the east: take I-76/US Route 224 West to State Route 21 and go south. Take State Route 21 South and go approximately 3 ½ miles to State Route 585 South. Take State Route 585 South and immediately exit at Hametown Road. Turn left onto Hametown Road and go ½ mile to the park entrance on the left.

Coming from the north: take I-77 South to State Route 21 and go south. Take State Route 21 South to State Route 585 South. Take State Route 585 South and immediately exit at Hametown Road. Turn left onto Hametown Road and go ½ mile to the park entrance on the left.
