White Spar Shelter at Silver Creek Metro Park

Capacity is 64. The shelter is accessed from the Lake House parking lot and is close to the lake. There are 8 picnic tables (2 are universally accessible), 2 charcoal only grills, (charcoal not provided), 2 electrical outlets and drinking water. Hiking trails and fishing are nearby. Also available: boat rental (during summer season only), playground nearby. The shelter is approximately 700 feet from the parking lot and is universally accessible. Parking may be limited. See the Permit Information and Guidelines sheet for details.

The restrooms are approximately 200 feet from the shelter and are universally accessible. **The restrooms are open seasonally (mid-April through mid-November).** There are lights inside the shelter and in the parking lot. Pets are not permitted in the buildings, or beach (designated days only), shelter, picnic, and play areas of the park. Always check the Summit Metro Parks website's "Alerts" page for the latest information on park conditions, including any trail closures. Smoking Restrictions: No person shall use tobacco or vapor products inside public buildings, lodges, open-air shelters, and during public programs. No person shall throw or place upon the ground or within lakes and waterways and lighted match, cigar, cigarette, or other burning substance.

Coming from the east: Take I-76/US Route 224 West to State Route 21 and go south. Take State Route 21 South and go approximately 3 ½ miles to State Route 585 South. Take State Route 585 South and immediately exit at Hametown Road. Turn left onto Hametown Road and go ½ mile to the park entrance on the left. Follow the road to the stop sign. Turn right and follow the road to the parking areas, on your first left.

Coming from the north: take I-77 South to State Route 21 and go south. Take State Route 21 South to State Route 585 South. Take State Route 585 South and immediately exit at Hametown Road. Turn left onto Hametown Road and go $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the park entrance on the left. Follow the road to the stop sign. Turn right and follow the road to the parking areas, on your first left.
